6	SECTION 1.(a) As used in this section, the term "physician offices" means any		
7	premises where a person licensed to practice medicine under Chapter 90 of the General Statutes,		
8	or where a professional association or corporation organized under Chapter 55B of the General		
9	Statutes, engages in the practice of medicine, as that term is defined in Article 1 of Chapter 90 of		
10	the General Statutes.		
11	SECTION 1.(b) The Legislative Research Commission (LRC) shall study whether		
12	North Carolina should enact legislation requiring that physician offices be capable of providing		
13	emergency electrical service for use in the event of failure of the normal electrical service.
