A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE 1987 GENERAL ASSEMBLY, 1988 SESSION, TO CONSIDER A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REENACT SECTION 1 OF CHAPTER 446, SESSION LAWS OF 1987, PROHIBITING CERTAIN INVESTMENTS IN CERTAIN COMPANIES INVOLVED IN SOUTH AFRICA WHICH WAS INADVERTENTLY REPEALED BY SECTION 5 OF CHAPTER 751, SESSION LAWS OF 1987, A REWRITE OF THE INVESTMENT POWERS OF THE STATE TREASURER.

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

Section 1. The 1987 General Assembly, Regular Session 1988, may consider "A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REENACT SECTION 1 OF CHAPTER 446, SESSION LAWS OF 1987, PROHIBITING CERTAIN INVESTMENTS IN CERTAIN COMPANIES INVOLVED IN SOUTH AFRICA WHICH WAS INADVERTENTLY REPEALED BY SECTION 5 OF CHAPTER 751, SESSION LAWS OF 1987, A REWRITE OF THE INVESTMENT POWERS OF THE STATE TREASURER."

Sec. 2. This resolution is effective upon ratification. In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 27th day of June, 1988.
