HOUSE BILL 941

1 AN ACT PERMITTING RESIDENTS OF THE STATE WHO ARE BLIND TO FISH IN
2 LAKE NORMAN WITHOUT A FISHING LICENSE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

6 **Section 1.** Subsection (c) of G.S. 113-271 is hereby designated as subsection (d).

7

8 **Sec. 2.** G.S. 113-271 is amended by inserting after subsection (b) a new subsection
(c) as follows:

9 "(c) Any person who has been a resident of the State for at least one year and who has
10 been certified by the North Carolina Commission for the Blind or a physician or optometrist as
11 a person whose vision with glasses is insufficient for use in ordinary occupations for which
12 sight is essential shall not be required to have a hook-and-line fishing license to fish in Lake
13 Norman provided such person at the time of fishing in Lake Norman is in attendance at Camp
14 Dogwood."

15 **Sec. 3.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

16 **Sec. 4.** This Act shall be in full force and effect upon ratification.
