## CHAPTER 342 HOUSE BILL 916

## AN ACT TO CORRECT TECHNICAL ERRORS IN CHAPTER 14 OF THE 1985 SESSION LAWS, KENLY CHARTER REVISION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Charter of the Town of Kenly, as contained in Section 1 of Chapter 14 of the 1985 Session Laws, is amended by rewriting Section 3.2 in Article III of the Charter to read:

"Sec. 3.2. Election of the Council Members. The Council members serving on the date of ratification of this Charter may continue to serve until expiration of their terms, or until their successors are elected and qualified. Council members shall continue to be elected and to serve on a four-year staggered term system. At the regular municipal election in 1985, and every four years thereafter, there shall be elected two Council members to fill the seats of those Council members whose terms are then expiring. At the regular municipal election in 1987, and every four years thereafter, there shall be elected three council members to fill the seats of those council members whose terms are then expiring. At the regular municipal election in 1987, and every four years thereafter, there shall be elected three council members to fill the seats of those council members whose terms are then expiring."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 6th day of June, 1985.
