CHAPTER 48
HOUSE BILL 178

AN ACT TO PERMIT PERSONS TO ENGAGE IN BUSINESS AS PAWNBROKERS
IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF HARNETT COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The last sentence of Section 4 of Chapter 1155, Session Laws of 1957, as amended by Chapters 382 and 968, Session Laws of 1983, is amended by adding immediately after the word "Pitt" the word ", Harnett".

Sec. 2. Section 3 of Chapter 169, Session Laws of 1983, as amended by Chapters 382 and 968, Session Laws of 1983, is amended by adding immediately after the word "Pitt" the word ", Harnett".

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 1st day of April, 1985.
