CHAPTER 950
SENATE BILL 926

AN ACT TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE CITY OF ASHEBORO
AND COUNTIES OF SCOTLAND, STANLY, UNION, AND RICHMOND MAIL
ZONING NOTICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 595, Session Laws of 1985 is amended by adding a new section to read:

"Sec. 2.1. This act does not apply to the City of Asheboro.
This act does not apply to the Counties of Scotland, Stanly, and Union, and Richmond
and does not apply to any incorporated cities or towns located wholly within those
counties."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 9th day of
July, 1986.
