CHAPTER 353
SENATE BILL 757

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN LEGAL QUALIFICATIONS SHALL
COUNT AS RELEVANT EXPERIENCE FOR APPLICANTS FOR A CERTIFIED
PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT EXAMINATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The next to the last sentence of G.S. 93-12(5) is rewritten to read:

"A Master's or more advanced degree in accounting, tax law, economics, business administration, or the equivalent thereof, or a law degree with emphasis in taxation or accounting from an accredited college or university may be substituted for one year of experience."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 12th day of June, 1987.
