CHAPTER 991  
HOUSE BILL 2351

AN ACT TO PERMIT THE GRANVILLE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION TO  
CHOOSE THE BUILDING CONTRACT SYSTEM IT USES FOR THE  
CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW MIDDLE SCHOOL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other laws or administrative rules to the contrary, the Granville County Board of Education may plan, develop, and construct a middle school using the single prime contract system, the separate prime contract system, the construction management contract system, or the design-build contract system.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and shall expire June 30, 1989, unless it is extended by the General Assembly.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 27th day of June, 1988.
