CHAPTER 995
HOUSE BILL 2463

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 806 OF THE 1987 SESSION LAWS TO PROVIDE
CHANGES ONLY WITH RESPECT TO PROJECTS WHOLLY SELF-
LIQUIDATING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The purpose of this act is to amend Section 2 of the 1987 Session Laws, Chapter 806, as it relates to Appalachian State University by increasing the amount authorized for the Expansion of Field House from one million ninety-five thousand eight hundred dollars (\$1,095,800) to one million three hundred eighty-nine thousand seven hundred dollars (\$1,389,700) and as it relates to The University of North Carolina at Greensboro by increasing the amount authorized for Student Recreation Facilities from seven million nine hundred eighty-eight thousand dollars (\$7,988,000) to ten million four hundred twenty-eight thousand nine hundred dollars (\$10,428,900), on a wholly self-liquidating basis.

Sec. 2. Section 2 of Chapter 806 of the 1987 Session Laws under the institutional subheading as indicated, and affecting only the projects listed in this act, is amended to read as follows:

1. Appalachian State University
Expansion of Field House \$ 1,389,700
4. The University of North Carolina at Greensboro
b. Student Recreation Facilities 10,428,900

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 27th day of June, 1988.
