**SESSION LAW 2019-65  
HOUSE BILL 240**

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE CITY OF ALBEMARLE TO USE CITY LABOR FOR CERTAIN  
WORK RELATED TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BUSINESS CENTER WITHOUT  
REGARD TO THE DOLLAR VALUE OF THE LABOR.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding G.S. 143-135, the City of Albemarle may use qualified labor on the permanent payroll of the City for the following work related to the construction of a business center:

- (1) Installation of electrical lines to the business center and up to any structure within the business center.
- (2) Installation of water and sewer lines to the business center and up to any structure within the business center.

**SECTION 2.** In carrying out the authority granted in this act, the City shall not be subject to the provisions of Article 8 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes, except for all of the following:

- (1) G.S. 143-128.2.
- (2) G.S. 143-128.3.
- (3) G.S. 143-129.

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law and expires on December 31, 2028.
