SENATE BILL 217**

AN ACT TO PREVENT CERTAIN PAYMENTS TO PRECINCT OFFICIALS WORKING IN  
THE 2020 GENERAL ELECTION FROM REDUCING UNEMPLOYMENT  
INSURANCE BENEFITS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Payments received by precinct officials and assistants under G.S. 163-46 for work performed during the period from September 1, 2020, until November 5, 2020, do not affect the computation of the individual's partial weekly benefit under G.S. 96-14.2(b).

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2020.
