Statewide Misdemeanant Confinement Program
Monthly Status Report
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The Statewide Misdemeanant Confinement Program (SMCP) manages the housing, transportation and medical expenses of state inmates housed in a local jail who have been convicted of a misdemeanor crime with a sentence of 91 days or more and those convicted of a misdemeanor Driving While Impaired (DWI) offense. The North Carolina Sheriffs' Association (NCSA) provides a critical role in managing the day-to-day operations of the program. The Monthly Status Report is prepared and submitted to all interested parties. The report includes the daily inmate population for the report month, the number of volunteered beds in the program, the number of confinements in response to violations (CRV's) for the month, the number of DWI's for the month, and the funds collected and expended year-to-date. The Monthly Status Report will be distributed no later than the last business day of each calendar month and will provide data of the SMCP from the previous calendar month.

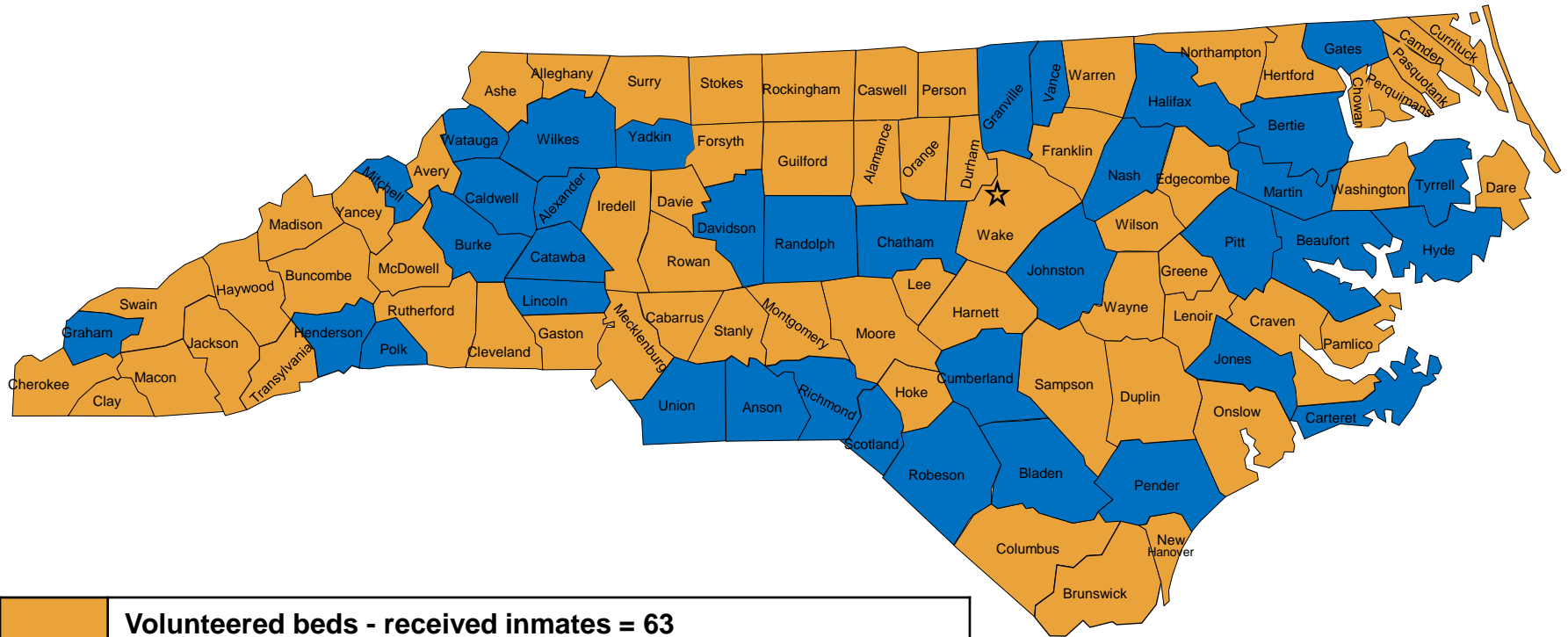

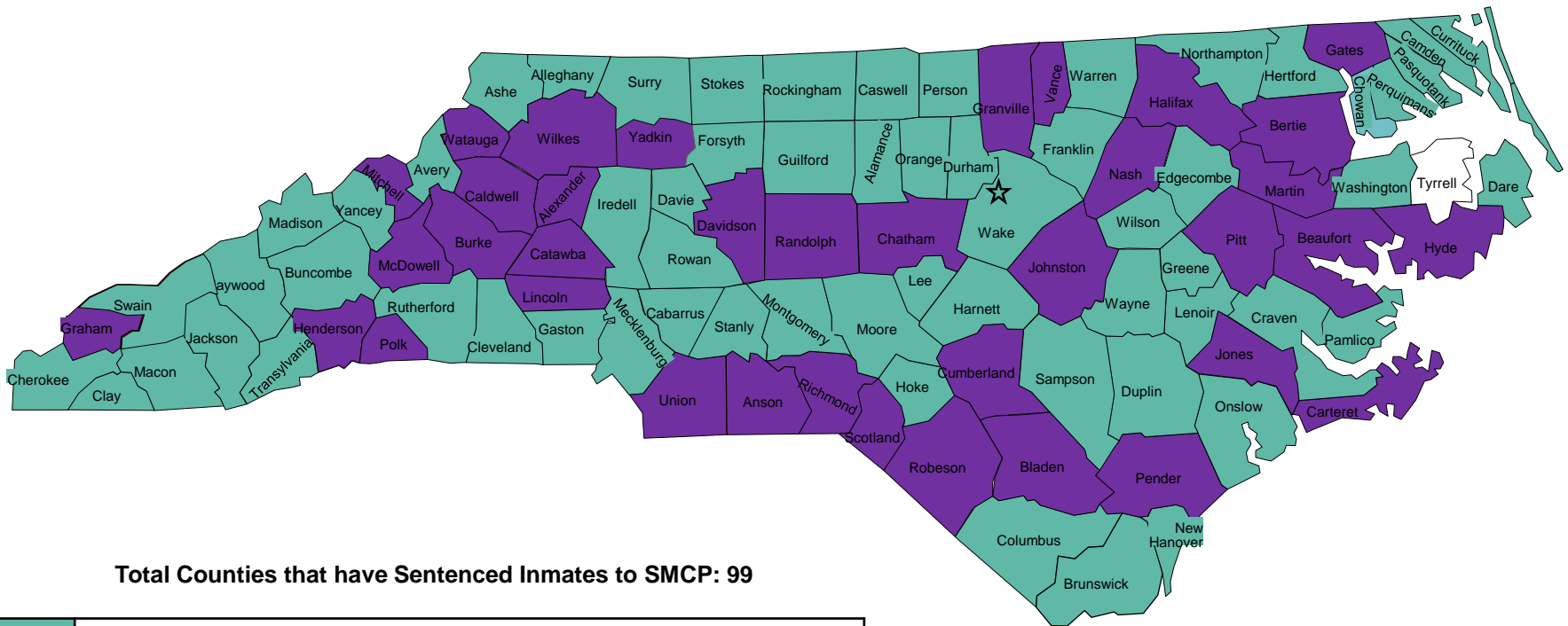
Counties that have Volunteered Beds to the Statewide Misdemeanant Confinement Program (SMCP)
