A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE HORNE CREEK FARM STATE
HISTORIC SITE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of one hundred fifty-seven thousand one hundred seventy-six dollars (\$157,176) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred twenty-seven thousand five hundred seventy-five dollars (\$127,575) for the 1990-91 fiscal year for personnel, equipment, and support expenses for the initial development of Horne Creek State Historic Site.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of seventy-seven thousand eight hundred dollars (\$77,800) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of ninety-one thousand five hundred dollars (\$91,500) for the 1990-91 fiscal year for capital improvements at Horne Creek State Historic Site, provided these funds are matched on a dollar-for-dollar basis by the North Carolina Living Historical Farm Committee, Inc.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
