A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO  
STUDY NO-FAULT AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the matter of no-fault or personal injury protection automobile insurance.

Sec. 2. In its study, the Commission may examine the present fault automobile insurance systems in North Carolina and other states, the no-fault or personal injury protection automobile insurance systems in other states, and make findings and recommendations regarding any changes for North Carolina that would benefit the citizens of this State.

Sec. 3. The Commission may report its findings, recommendations, and any proposed legislation to the 1991 General Assembly.

Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
