A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO VARIOUS PUBLIC SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS IN MITCHELL COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Cane Creek Community Club, Inc., in Mitchell County the sum of six thousand five hundred dollars (\$6,500) for the 1989-90 fiscal year for water and sewer lines.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Bakersville Community Medical Clinic, Incorporated, in Mitchell County the sum of eight thousand dollars (\$8,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year for capital improvements.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to The North Carolina Rhododendron Festival, Inc., in Mitchell County the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the promotion of travel and tourism of North Carolina.

Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Mitchell County Historical Society, Inc., the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year to set up and maintain two additional historic exhibits.

Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Mitchell County for the Office of Inspection the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) for the 1989-90 fiscal year to set up computer systems.

Sec. 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
