A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE TAX CHECK OFF FOR POLITICAL PARTIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Effective with respect to taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 1989, G.S. 105-159.1 is repealed.

Sec. 2. Effective January 1, 1993, Article 22B of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes, constituting G.S. 163-278.41 through G.S. 163-278.43, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Prosecutions for offenses occurring before the effective date of Section 2 of this act are not abated or affected by that section, and the statutes that would be applicable but for that section remain applicable to those prosecutions.

Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
