G.S. 20-10.1 reads as rewritten: 8 "§ 20-10.1. Mopeds. 9 10 It shall be unlawful for any person, while his driver's license is suspended or revoked, or who is under the age of 16 years to operate a moped as defined in G.S. 20-11 12 4.01(27)d1 upon any highway or public vehicular area of this State." Sec. 2. Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new 13 14 section to read: 15 "§ 20-140.5. Special provisions for mopeds. (a) No person shall operate a moped, as defined in G.S. 20-4.01(27)d1 upon a 16 highway or public vehicular area unless the operator of the moped and all passengers on 17 the moped wear safety helmets of a type approved by the Commissioner. 18 (b) No person shall operate a moped on a highway where the posted speed 19

limit is greater than 35 miles per hour."
