5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6 Section 1. G.S. 7A-273 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
7 "(9) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (1) of this section,
8 to accept written appearances, waivers of trial and pleas of guilty in
9 violations of G.S. 14-399 and enter judgments in those cases as the
10 chief district judge directs."
11 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989.
