1 AN ACT AN ACT TO PERMIT THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION
2 TO STUDY THE USE OF OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES ON STATE, COUNTY,
3 AND MUNICIPAL LANDS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. (a) The Legislative Research Commission may study the use of off-
7 highway vehicles on State, county, and municipal public lands. The Legislative
8 Research Commission may, in studying this subject, consider:

9 (1) The definition of "off-highway vehicles";

10 (2) The definition of "public lands";

11 (3) The regulation or prohibition of the use of off-highway vehicles on
12 public lands;

13 (4) Any other matters the Commission deems appropriate in considering
14 the subject matter of this study.

15 (b) The Legislative Research Commission shall report any findings and
16 recommendations from the study authorized in subsection (a) of this section to the 1991
17 Session of the General Assembly and may make an interim report to the 1990 Session
18 of the General Assembly.

19 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
