A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR OLD SALEM, INCORPORATED, IN  
FORSYTH COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Old Salem, Incorporated, in Forsyth County the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 1990-91 fiscal year to be used by Old Salem, Incorporated, in interpreting life in the eighteenth century town of Salem to school children and adult visitors. These funds shall not become part of the continuation budget. Any unexpended funds at the end of the biennium shall not revert to the General Fund but remain available for use by Old Salem, Incorporated.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
