Short Title: Multiflora Rose Funds.

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE MULTIFLORA ROSE
3 RESEARCH AND EXTENSION PROGRAM AT NORTH CAROLINA STATE
4 UNIVERSITY, COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND LIFE SCIENCES.

5 Whereas, multiflora rose is a serious problem in noncropland habitats in
6 Western North Carolina; and

7 Whereas, rose bushes growing on rights-of-ways and other noncropland areas
8 block visibility, inhibit inspection and maintenance activities, and encroach into
9 adjacent pastures and croplands; and

10 Whereas, North Carolina State University has an existing faculty position that
11 provides leadership for developing management programs to assist in controlling this
12 plant pest; Now, therefore,

13 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

14 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
15 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of thirty-two thousand seven
16 hundred twenty-six dollars (\$32,726) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of thirty-
17 two thousand seven hundred twenty-six dollars (\$32,726) for the 1990-91 fiscal year to
18 provide technical assistance, supplies and travel to conduct a field-oriented research and
19 extension program to aid in managing multiflora rose.

20 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
