A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AN INVENTORY OF NATURAL
AREAS IN JACKSON COUNTY.

Whereas, the continued population growth and land development in Jackson County have made it necessary and desirable that areas of outstanding natural significance be identified and preserved; and

Whereas, these natural areas are important for their ecological, educational, scientific, cultural, recreational, and aesthetic values; and

Whereas, the Natural Heritage Program, a unit of the Department of Natural Resources and Community Development's Division of Parks and Recreation, estimates that the total cost for conducting a countywide inventory of natural areas, preparing final reports and identifying land owners is \$15,000; Now, therefore, The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Parks and Recreation, \$7,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for a natural areas inventory of Jackson County to be conducted by the Natural Heritage Program of the Division of Parks and Recreation.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
