20	Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carol	ina				
21	Center for the Study of Black History, Incorporated, \$350,000 for the 1989-90 fis	cal				
22	year and \$500,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for operating expenses.					
23	Sec. 3. The North Carolina Center for the Study of Black Histo	ry,				
24	Incorporated, shall make a written report annually commencing on the first day of M	lay				

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- 1 1990 and each year thereafter on the use of the funds appropriated for the 1989-90 fiscal
- 2 year in Sections 1 and 2 of this act.
- 3 Sec. 4. The Office of State Budget shall disburse the funds appropriated in
- 4 Section 1 of this act by August 1, 1989, and shall disburse the funds appropriated in
- 5 Section 2 of this act by August 1, 1990.
- 6 Sec. 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
