A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SERVICES FOR UNDISCIPLINED
JUVENILES AND THEIR FAMILIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Bringing It All Back Home Study Center at Appalachian State University \$41,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$41,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year, to allow the Center to continue its home remedies community-based alternatives program for undisciplined juveniles and their families.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Youth and Family Counselling Service \$80,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$80,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year, to allow the Service to continue the Grimes Alternative School Model Program, a community-based alternatives program for undisciplined juveniles in the public schools in Davidson County.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
