A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A UNIVERSITY OF NORTH
2 CAROLINA STUDY OF THE NEED FOR A REQUIREMENT OF MINIMUM
3 TEACHING HOURS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. The Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina shall
7 study the need to require a minimum number of classroom hours to be taught by full,
8 associate, and assistant professors and instructors at The University of North Carolina
9 and to reevaluate the use of graduate students as classroom teachers.

10 This study shall include an analysis of the number of classroom hours taught
11 by full, associate, and assistant professors and instructors at each of the constituent
12 institutions of The University of North Carolina and of the number of hours taught at
13 each institution by graduate students. This study shall also include an evaluation of the
14 need to require a minimum number of classroom teaching hours of full, associate, and
15 assistant professors and instructors.

16 The Board of Governors shall report the results of this study to the 1989
17 General Assembly, Regular Session 1990.

18 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
19 Governors of The University of North Carolina \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to
20 implement this act.

21 Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
