A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A COMMUNITY
CENTER IN WALKERTOWN, IN FORSYTH COUNTY.

Whereas, Walkertown is one of North Carolina's newest incorporated towns;
and

Whereas, Walkertown has been working towards enriching its community;
and

Whereas, a community center is vitally important in serving the educational,
social, cultural, and recreational needs of all the citizens of a rural community; and

Whereas, Walkertown needs funds for construction of a community center;

Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of
Walkertown \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for construction of a community center
for community activities. This appropriation shall be matched with non-State funds on
a dollar-for-dollar basis.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
