A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CLASSROOM ADDITION TO THE GIBSONVILLE SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER, IN GUILFORD COUNTY.

Whereas, senior citizens centers provide vital services to rural communities; and

Whereas, senior citizens centers serve to promote educational, social, cultural, and recreational activities of the elderly; and

Whereas, the Gibsonville senior citizens center serves as a positive benefit to its community by providing its elderly population with various activities; and

Whereas, a classroom addition to the Gibsonville senior citizens center will provide its senior citizens the opportunity for educational and tutorial programs; and

Whereas, funds are needed for the construction of a classroom addition to the Gibsonville senior citizens center; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Gibsonville, in Guilford County, \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for construction of a classroom addition to the existing senior citizens center, which will be used primarily for educational programs for the elderly citizens in the Gibsonville area. This appropriation shall be matched with non-State funds on a dollar-for-dollar basis.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
