G.S. 105-141(b)(18) reads as rewritten: "(18) Any amount not to exceed four thousand dollars (\$4,000) received by a taxpayer during any year as (i) retired or retainer pay as a result of service in any of the armed forces of the United States. States or (ii) military survivor benefits for survivors of persons retired from service in any of the armed forces of the United States." Sec. 2. This act is effective for taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 1989.
