A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE NORTHAMPTON COUNTY
SCHOOLS TO RELIEVE THE EMERGENCY CRISIS AT THE SCHOOLS TO
REPAIR DAMAGES CAUSED BY A MARCH 20, 1989, TORNADO.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Northampton
County Schools \$218,336 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to relieve emergency conditions as
a result of damages caused by a tornado on March 20, 1989. These funds shall be used:

- (1) To purchase and set up seven mobile classrooms at Jackson-Eastside and Willis Hare;
- (2) Installation of telephone lines to Jackson-Eastside and Willis Hare;
- (3) Replace gravel for walks and bus parking at Willis Hare;
- (4) Purchase four security lights for Jackson-Eastside and Willis Hare;
- (5) Fees to tear down and remove mobile units from Garysburg when Jackson-Eastside returns to replaced building in late summer;
- (6) Put outdoor playground in a usable condition at Willis Hare;
- (7) Provide electrical circuits in classrooms to provide for computers and audio-visual equipment;
- (8) Purchase six dividers with chalkboards;
- (9) Purchase seventeen dividers; and
- (10) Restore landscaping at campuses of Jackson-Eastside and Willis Hare.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
