May 4, 1989 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE TOWN OF BOONE, IN WATAUGA COUNTY, FOR COMMUNITY PROJECTS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Boone, in Watauga County, \$9,340 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to complete the furnishing of the Jones House Community Center with a functional office and program equipment. Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Boone, in Watauga County, \$4,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to begin a nine-month study for

conversion of the former all-black Junaluska School into a regional art center.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
