A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE TOWN OF BOONE IN WATAUGA
COUNTY, FOR NETWORKING LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Boone, in Watauga County, \$37,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to provide networking of the law enforcement agencies of Boone, Blowing Rock, Seven Devils, and the Blue Ridge Parkway. These funds will provide these rural mountainous communities with

computer, communication, and tactical equipment needed to collect, analyze, and exchange information, especially narcotics interdiction information in a region that is

abound with back roads and unexplored terrain.
