A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH AN ALAMANCE COUNTY
ALZHEIMER'S DAY CARE PILOT PROJECT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Friendship Center of Alamance, Inc., \$30,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to establish and direct an Adult Day Care Pilot Project in Alamance County for clients with Alzheimer's Disease and related disorders or with other mental impairments. The Center shall report to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Mental Health, Mental Retardation, and Substance Abuse Services, and to the General Assembly by May 1, 1990, on the progress of the pilot project, and on recommendations as to whether the pilot should be used as a model for statewide implementation.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
