A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH,
MENTAL RETARDATION AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES, FOR THE
PURPOSE OF PROVIDING MATCHING FUNDS FOR THE ROBERT WOOD
JOHNSON CHILD MENTAL HEALTH PROJECT.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of three hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$325,000) for fiscal year 1990-91 to the Division of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services, Department of Human Resources to provide matching funds as required for the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Grant of seven hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$725,000) for a child mental health demonstration project.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
