Section 1. Chapter 1 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new Article to read:

"ARTICLE 43E.

"DUTY TO PROVIDE MEDICAL ADVICE AND COUNSELING ON ABORTION.

"§ 1-539.25. Duty to advise and counsel abortion patients.

- (a) A person authorized to perform abortions in this State shall, before performing the abortion, provide medical advice and counseling to the woman seeking the abortion regarding the potential medical, physiological, and psychological consequences of having an abortion.
- (b) A person who fails to comply with subsection (a) shall be liable to the woman upon whom the person performed an abortion, for severe mental distress proximately caused by the abortion.
- (c) Actual and punitive damages shall be recoverable in an action brought under this section."
- Sec. 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 1990, and shall apply to abortions performed on or after that date.
