May 5, 1989 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO TRIANGLE LAND CONSERVANCY FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A PARKING AREA AND TRAILS FOR THE FLOWER HILL PRESERVATION PROJECT IN JOHNSTON COUNTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Triangle Land Conservancy the sum of \$10,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to develop a parking area and trails for the Flower Hill Preservation Project, a site in Johnston County of both historical and ecological significance that is a unique natural area sustaining the largest stand of native purple rhododendron found in the North Carolina coastal plain. 10 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
