Short Title: Alt. Sentencing Funds.

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Union County \$62,400 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the start-up and first year operation expenses of a community-based alternative sentencing center in lieu of incarceration for certain youthful offenders who are awaiting trial in juvenile court, for the 34th House District of Cabarrus, Stanly, and Union Counties.

This appropriation shall be matched by Union County on a dollar-for-dollar basis. The matching funds may be in the form of in-kind services, facilities, or monies, to the satisfaction and accountability of the Department of Administration.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
