There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Education \$7,333,400 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to reimburse the local boards of education for the additional costs they incur in paying school maintenance personnel on the salary schedule the State Board of Education adopts pursuant to G.S. 115C-12(16)b.

This appropriation shall become a part of the continuation budget but shall be phased out by decreasing the amount by \$1,466,680 each year, beginning with the 1991-92 fiscal year.

Sec. 3. Section 1 of this act shall become effective July 1, 1990. Section 2 of this act shall become effective July 1, 1989.

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
