A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH INDEPENDENT LIVING REHABILITATION PROGRAMS IN WILMINGTON AND HICKORY TO SERVE THE CITIZENS OF THOSE CITIES AND SURROUNDING AREAS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Vocational Rehabilitation Services, the sum of \$677,754 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of \$763,458 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$338,877 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$381,729 for the 1990-91 fiscal year shall be used to establish and operate an independent living rehabilitation center and program in Wilmington that will serve New Hanover, Columbus, Brunswick, Pender, Duplin, and Onslow Counties.
- (2) \$338,877 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$381,729 for the 1990-91 fiscal year shall be used to establish and operate an independent living rehabilitation center and program in Hickory that will serve Catawba, Burke, Caldwell, Alexander, Lincoln, and Cleveland Counties.
- Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
