1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC 3 EDUCATION FOR VOCATIONAL EDUCATION EQUIPMENT. Whereas, it has been determined that there is a need for one hundred million 4 dollars (\$100,000,000) of vocational education equipment in order to bring the program 5 up to an appropriate standard; and 6 Whereas, the General Assembly is now appropriating the necessary funds to 7 pay the base salary for all regular vocational education teachers; and 8 9 Whereas, the General Assembly has determined, as long ago as 1977, that vocational education is to "... be an integral part of the education process" (G.S. 115C-10 151); and 11 12

Whereas, the General Assembly has determined that vocational education "...shall be offered ..."as a part of the Basic Education Program (G.S. 115C-81); Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Education the sum of twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) for the 1990-91 fiscal year to be allocated to local school administrative units for the purchase of vocational education equipment.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
