**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PROVIDE INDIGENT CARE AND  
LONG-TERM NURSING CARE AT L. RICHARDSON MEMORIAL HOSPITAL  
IN GREENSBORO.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the L. Richardson Memorial Hospital, Incorporated, in Greensboro \$200,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$200,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to be used for indigent care and long-term nursing care at the hospital, which is the only remaining black hospital in the South.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
