A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO VARIOUS PUBLIC PROJECTS IN THE
GREENSBORO AREA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Young Men's Christian Association of Greensboro, Inc., \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be used to support the tutorial programs at the Hayes Taylor YMCA which enrich the entire community.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Black Child Development Institute of Greensboro, Inc., \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be used to support the Institute's tutorial and enrichment programs.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Pleasant Garden Community Center, Inc., in Guilford County \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to support its public service programs which benefit the entire community.

Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Youth Services of Guilford, Inc., \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be used for its Best Friends Program for disadvantaged troubled youth.

Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the United Negro College Fund in Forsyth County \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be used to provide funding for scholarships for needy students.

Sec. 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Greensboro Housing Authority \$3,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be used for its tutorial program for disadvantaged youth in the Claremont Courts community.

1 Sec. 7. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Episcopal Church
2 of the Redeemer in Greensboro \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be used for its
3 project care program, a tutorial program designed to help children in the Greensboro
4 area prepare for tests, including the PSAT and the SAT and to achieve better learning
5 skills.

6 Sec. 8. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
