A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR VARIOUS COMMUNITY PROJECTS
IN COLUMBUS COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Lake Waccamaw in Columbus County the sum of \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to assist in aquatic weed control.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the St. James Volunteer Fire Department in Columbus County the sum of \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses and equipment.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the White Marsh-Welches Creek Community Volunteer Fire Department in Columbus County the sum of \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses and equipment.

Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Buckhead Volunteer Fire Department in Columbus County the sum of \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses and equipment.

Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Ransom Activity Center, Inc., in Columbus County, the sum of \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses.

Sec. 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
