A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO VARIOUS COMMUNITY PROJECTS IN
COLUMBUS COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Tabor City the sum of \$1,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses of the Tabor City Recreation Park.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Tabor City (Restoration Project) the sum of \$1,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to assist Tabor City in vital restoration projects.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Tabor City the sum of \$1,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses of the Tabor City Committee of 100.

Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Fair Bluff the sum of \$1,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses of the Fair Bluff Chamber of Commerce in providing public service projects.

Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Carver Community Center, Inc., the sum of \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses.

Sec. 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Fair Bluff the sum of \$1,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses of the American Legion Post 204 for its public services programs.

1 Sec. 7. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Club Fifteen Civic
2 League of Tabor City, North Carolina, Inc., in Columbus County, the sum of \$1,000 for
3 the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses in providing public service projects.

4 Sec. 8. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
