A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A PILOT PROJECT TO  
2 DEMONSTRATE AN ALTERNATIVE WAY OF SHARING AND  
3 TRANSFERRING INFORMATION BETWEEN A LOCAL CRIMINAL JUSTICE  
4 INFORMATION SYSTEM AND THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE  
5 COURTS.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Administrative  
9 Office of the Courts \$150,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for a pilot project to  
10 demonstrate an alternative method of sharing and transferring information between the  
11 Administrative Office of the Courts and the local criminal justice system that includes  
12 the Asheville City Police Department, the Buncombe County Sheriff's Department,  
13 local magistrates, the local City-County ID Bureau, the local jail, and the District  
14 Attorney's Office.

15 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
