Whereas, family practitioners and obstetricians who provide maternity care to Medicaid women are currently paid fifty-four percent (54%) of their average charge; and

Whereas, growing malpractice insurance costs continue to reduce the availability of prenatal and delivery services throughout the State; and

Whereas, the active involvement of family practitioners and obstetricians in providing maternal care to Medicaid women is critical to solving North Carolina's rising infant mortality problem; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Medical Assistance, the sum of \$2,380,360 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of \$3,332,504 for the 1990-91 fiscal year, for the State's share of increasing physician reimbursement for maternity care services effective October 1, 1989.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
