A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Catholic Social Services of the Diocese of Charlotte, North Carolina, Inc., \$76,000 for the 1989-90 fixed wear for exercising expanses incurred in providing recettlement programs and

Services of the Diocese of Charlotte, North Carolina, Inc., \$76,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for operating expenses incurred in providing resettlement programs and services to refugees seeking a new life in North Carolina. These programs and services are provided to any refugee regardless of race or religion. These funds represent the amount the federal government has cut from the resettlement program for the fiscal year.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
