A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SPECIAL PROJECTS IN THE FIFTY-SEVENTH HOUSE DISTRICT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Lions Services, Inc., \$2,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for general operating expenses to expand services to the blind citizens of the Greater Charlotte community.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to The Charlotte Shakespeare Company \$1,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year so that The Charlotte Shakespeare Company can continue to provide free professional theater to the citizens of North Carolina.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to St. Mark's Center, Inc., \$3,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to purchase special equipment and materials for the mentally retarded children and adults that St. Mark's Center in Charlotte serves.

Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Metrolina Association for the Blind, Inc., \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for general operating expenses and to expand special services for the blind citizens of the Metrolina area.

Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources \$5,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for general operating expenses for The Relatives, Inc., a family crisis intervention and counseling center in Charlotte, North Carolina.

Sec. 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Family Housing Services, Inc., \$3,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for general operating expenses so that

- 1 Family Housing Services, Inc., can continue to provide services to low-income families
- 2 and to assist in preventing foreclosures on homes.
- 3 Sec. 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
