A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO VOLUNTEER FIRE AND RESCUE
SQUADS IN GATES, HERTFORD, AND NORTHAMPTON COUNTIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Gates County \$13,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be distributed to the following fire and rescue squads in the amounts indicated for capital improvements and program implementation:

Gates County Rescue Squad	\$5,000
Eure Volunteer Fire Department	\$1,500
Gates Volunteer Fire Department	\$1,500
Gatesville Volunteer Fire Department	\$1,500
Hobbsville Volunteer Fire Department	\$2,500
Sunbury Volunteer Fire Department	\$1,500.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Hertford County \$22,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be distributed to the following fire and rescue squads in the amount of \$1,500 each for capital improvements and program implementation: Winton Volunteer Fire Department; Murfreesboro Volunteer Fire Department; Coelfield Volunteer Fire Department; St. John's Volunteer Fire Department; Hoskie Volunteer Fire Department; Harrellsville Volunteer Fire Department; Union Volunteer Fire Department; Millenium Volunteer Fire Department; Co Miocomo Fire Department; Ahoskie Volunteer Fire Department; Ahoskie Rescue Squad; Como Rescue Squad; Harrells Rescue Squad; Murfreesboro Rescue Squad; Winton Rescue Squad.

1 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Northampton County
2 \$22,500 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be distributed to the following fire and rescue
3 squads in the amount of \$1,500 each for capital improvements and program
4 implementation: Conway Volunteer Fire Department; Jackson Volunteer Fire
5 Department; Lasker Volunteer Fire Department; Garysburg Volunteer Fire Department;
6 Seaboard Volunteer Fire Department; Severn Volunteer Fire Department; Gaston
7 Volunteer Fire Department; Woodland Volunteer Fire Department; Rich Square
8 Volunteer Fire Department; Roanoke-Wildwood Volunteer Fire Department; Rich
9 Square Volunteer Rescue Squad; Woodland Volunteer Rescue Squad; Jackson
10 Volunteer Rescue Squad; Gaston Volunteer Rescue Squad; Conway/Severn Volunteer
11 Rescue Squad.

12 Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Bertie County \$3,000
13 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to be distributed to the following fire and rescue squads in
14 the amount of \$1,500 each for capital improvements and program implementation:
15 Lewiston Woodville Volunteer Fire Department; Lewiston Woodville Volunteer Rescue
16 Squad.

17 Sec. 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
