A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR VARIOUS PUBLIC PROJECTS IN THE  
FOURTEENTH HOUSE DISTRICT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Brunswick County \$57,000 to be used for public service programs and projects. These funds shall be allocated for the following public purposes in the following amounts:

- (1) \$5,000 for Hope Harbor Home, Inc., to be used for capital improvements to enable Hope Harbor to continue to serve battered women and children;
- (2) \$5,000 for the Holden Beach Senior Citizens Association, Inc., to be used for capital improvements to the facility used by senior citizens;
- (3) \$5,000 for the Lower Cape Fear Hospice, Inc., to be used for the expansion of services to hospice patients and to the community;
- (4) \$5,000 for the Brunswick County Literacy Council, Inc., to be used for publicity and educational materials to combat illiteracy;
- (5) \$2,000 for the South Brunswick Islands Chamber of Commerce to be used for the promotion of the North Carolina Oyster Festival;
- (6) \$2,000 for the City of Southport to be used for promotion of the annual North Carolina Fourth of July Festival;
- (7) \$2,000 for the Town of Holden Beach to be used for the promotion of the Holden Beach Festival by the Sea;
- (8) \$5,000 for the Brunswick County Friends of the Library to be used for capital improvements to the Leland Library;

- 1           (9)   \$2,000 for the Southport-Oak Island Area Chamber of Commerce,  
2           Inc., to be used for promotion of the Christmas by the Sea Festival;  
3           (10)  \$2,000 for the Community Building of Southport, Inc., to be used for  
4           capital improvements to the community building;  
5           (11)  \$2,000 for the Brunswick County Youth Wrestling Association to be  
6           used for promotional activities;  
7           (12)  \$5,000 for the North Brunswick Booster Club to be used for capital  
8           improvements;  
9           (13)  \$5,000 for the West Brunswick Booster Club to be used for capital  
10          improvements;  
11          (14)  \$5,000 for the South Brunswick Booster Club to be used for capital  
12          improvements;  
13          (15)  \$3,000 for the Brunswick County Amateur Radio Society, Inc., to be  
14          used to purchase equipment for the society;  
15          (16)  \$2,000 for the Brunswick County NAACP to be used for the ACT-SO  
16          funds project.

17          Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to New Hanover County  
18 \$12,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for public service projects and programs. These  
19 funds shall be allocated for the following public purposes in the following amounts:

- 20          (1)   \$5,000 for the Castle Hayne Volunteer Fire Department, Inc., to be  
21          used for the purchase of equipment for the department;  
22          (2)   \$5,000 for the Wrightsboro Volunteer Fire Department to be used for  
23          the purchase of equipment for the department;  
24          (3)   \$2,000 for the Bellevue Cemetery Perpetual Care Fund to be used for  
25          operating expenses. This appropriation shall be matched with non-  
26          State funds on a dollar-for-dollar basis.

27          Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Pender County \$8,000  
28 for the 1989-90 fiscal year for public service projects and programs. These funds shall  
29 be allocated for the following public purposes in the following amounts:

- 30          (1)   \$2,000 for the Greater Topsail Area Chamber of Commerce, Inc., to be  
31          used for promotion of the Topsail Island Spring Jubilee;  
32          (2)   \$3,000 for the Hampstead Community Building, Inc., to be used for  
33          capital improvements to the community building;  
34          (3)   \$3,000 for the Topsail Recreation Association to be used to support the  
35          association's recreational activities in the community.

36          Sec. 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
