AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ENCOURAGE AND PROMOTE THE
DEVELOPMENT OF MINORITY AND SMALL BUSINESSES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

- Section 1. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., the sum of \$2,000,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of \$2,000,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for grants to be disbursed to Community Development Corporations which are incorporated under Chapter 55A of the General Statutes and which serve minority and underdeveloped communities.
- (b) The Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., shall make a written report by May 1, 1990, to the General Assembly on the use of the funds appropriated under subsection (a) of this section.
- Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina Institute of Minority Economic Development the sum of \$1,000,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of \$1,000,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year for administration costs and for research projects pertaining to minority and small business development.
 - Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
